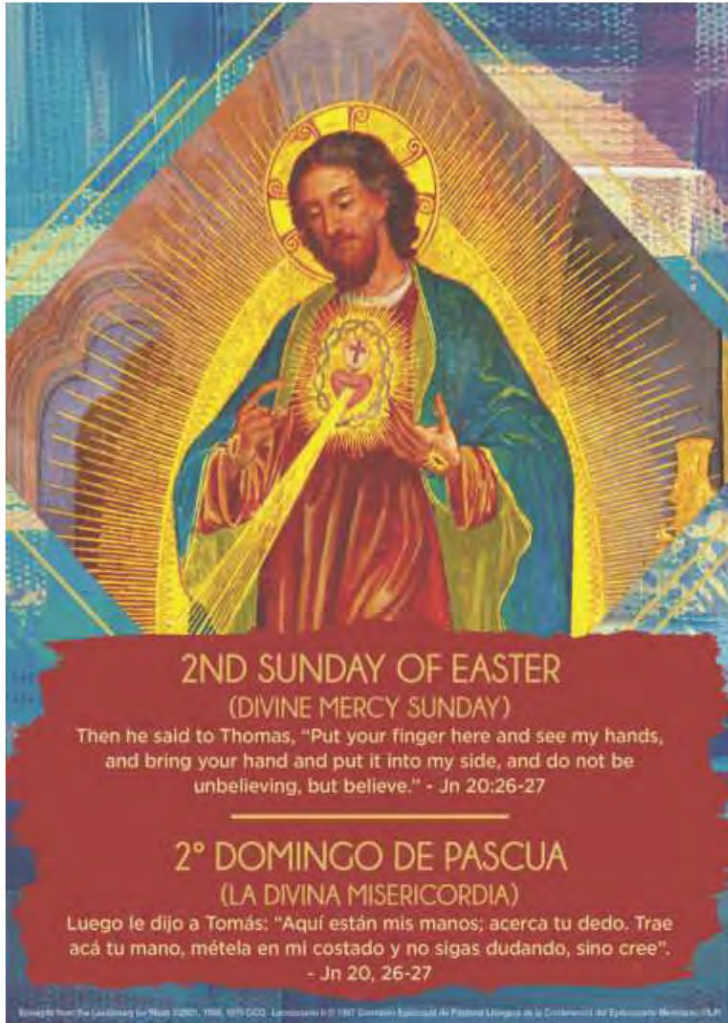
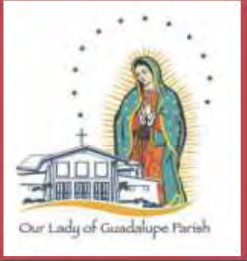

MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Why is today **Divine Mercy Sunday**? On April 30, 2000, then Pope St. John Paul II **canonized** a Polish nun, Saint Mary Faustina Kowalska, who had received from Christ the amazing **revelations of the Divine Mercy**.

During that ceremony, the Pope dedicated the Second Sunday of the Easter Season to **honor and commemorate** God's infinite mercy. Where do we see this mercy revealed? May be the example of St. Thomas in today's Gospel should help us understand it better. Of all the Apostles, perhaps Thomas experienced this mercy most dramatically.

Thomas was **mad** that Jesus had failed. So, when he finally heard the news of the Resurrection, he wouldn't accept it: "*Unless I see the mark of the nails... I will not believe it.*" So, when Jesus comes through those locked doors once again, and after wishing them **peace** what does he do? His **very next words** are for Thomas: "*Touch my wounds, Thomas; believe in me!*"

And Thomas falls on his knees and is the first Apostle to proclaim his faith in Christ's divinity, calling him "**My Lord and my God**", the very titles given to God throughout the whole Old Testament. We are all Doubting Thomases at times. We all resist God's action in our lives in one way or another. And it is precisely in those moments and those corners of our lives where Jesus wants to show off his boundless mercy, come down to our level, and win back our faith.

This week we also celebrate the Vocations event to celebrate and thank God for the growth of vocations in our Parish. We thank Bishop Michael Barber and Fr. Carl Acosta in reaching out to the youth of our parish and encouraging and guiding them in the path to Priesthood and Religious life. **Let's all be instruments of God's Mercy to one another and pray for many more Holy Vocations in the Diocese of Oakland!**

MENSAJE DEL PÁRROCO

¿Por qué hoy es Domingo de la Divina Misericordia? El 30 de abril de 2000, el entonces Papa San Juan Pablo II canonizó a una monja polaca, Santa María Faustina Kowalska, quien había recibido de Cristo las sorprendentes **revelaciones de la Divina Misericordia**.

Durante esa ceremonia, el Papa dedicó el Segundo Domingo del Tiempo Pascual a **honrar y conmemorar** la infinita misericordia de Dios. ¿Dónde vemos esta misericordia revelada? Quizá el ejemplo de Santo Tomás en el Evangelio de hoy nos ayude a comprenderlo mejor. De todos los Apóstoles, quizás Tomás experimentó esta misericordia de manera más dramática.

Tomás estaba **enojado** porque Jesús había fallado. Entonces, cuando finalmente escuchó la noticia de la Resurrección, no lo aceptaría: *"A menos que vea la marca de los clavos... no lo creeré"*. Entonces, cuando Jesús entra por esas puertas cerradas una vez más, y después de desearles paz, ¿qué hace? Sus próximas palabras son para Tomás: *"Toca mis heridas, Tomás; cree en mí!"*

Y Tomás cae de rodillas y es el primer Apóstol en proclamar su fe en la divinidad de Cristo, llamándolo **"Señor mío y Dios mío"**, los mismos títulos dados a Dios a lo largo de todo el Antiguo Testamento. Todos somos Tomás incrédulos a veces. Todos resistimos a la acción de Dios en nuestras vidas de una forma u otra. Y es precisamente en esos momentos y en esos rincones de nuestras vidas donde Jesús quiere mostrarnos su misericordia sin límites, ponerse a nuestro nivel y recuperar nuestra fe.

Esta semana también celebramos el evento de las Vocaciones para celebrar y agradecer a Dios por el crecimiento de las Vocaciones en nuestra Parroquia. Agradecemos al Obispo Michael Barber y al Padre Carl Acosta en llegar a los jóvenes de nuestra parroquia y alentarlos y guiarlos en el camino hacia el sacerdocio y la vida religiosa. **¡Seamos todos instrumentos de la Misericordia de Dios unos con otros y oremos por muchas más Santas Vocaciones en la Diócesis de Oakland!**

FAMILY ENRICHMENT

“Family First” / “La Familia Primero”

Do you feel that no one at your home meets your needs?

As Spouse and Parents, you want to be generous and take care of others, at the same time you feel that your needs are not met. When this happens constantly, you become like a car running low on gas or love. Taking care of your needs is not selfish. You may find it difficult to identify and express your need, your spouse may decline, turn down, pretend as if you have no need. When your needs are not met, your needs build-up and one day you blaze out with anger, resentment, and blame.

What do you do about this?

When expressing your need, don't use the words, “You are always doing or saying that to me”, instead, “I feel hurt when you do or say that to me”.

Prayerfully approach what you 'want' and being flexible about 'how' and 'when' you want to meet those needs is important.

Most of the needs can be met while still helping other people in the family and get their needs met.

Do this.

Take a picture & send to your son or daughter.

¿Sientes que nadie en tu casa satisface tus necesidades?

Como Cónyuge y Padre, desea ser generoso y cuidar de los demás, al mismo tiempo que siente que sus necesidades no son satisfechas. Cuando esto sucede constantemente, te vuelves como un auto que se queda sin gasolina o sin amor. Cuidar de sus necesidades no es egoísta. Puede que le resulte difícil identificar y expresar su necesidad, su cónyuge puede negarse, rechazar, pretender que no tiene ninguna necesidad. Cuando no se satisfacen sus necesidades, sus necesidades se acumulan y un día estalla en ira, resentimiento y culpa.

¿Qué haces al respecto?

Quando expresas tu necesidad, no uses las palabras “siempre me haces o me dices eso”, sino “me siento herido cuando me haces o me dices eso”.

Acérquese con oración a lo que 'quiere' y es importante ser flexible sobre 'cómo' y 'cuándo' quiere satisfacer esas necesidades.

La mayoría de las necesidades se pueden satisfacer mientras se ayuda a otras personas de la familia y se satisfacen sus necesidades.

Hagan esto.
