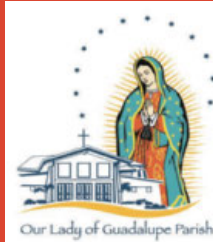

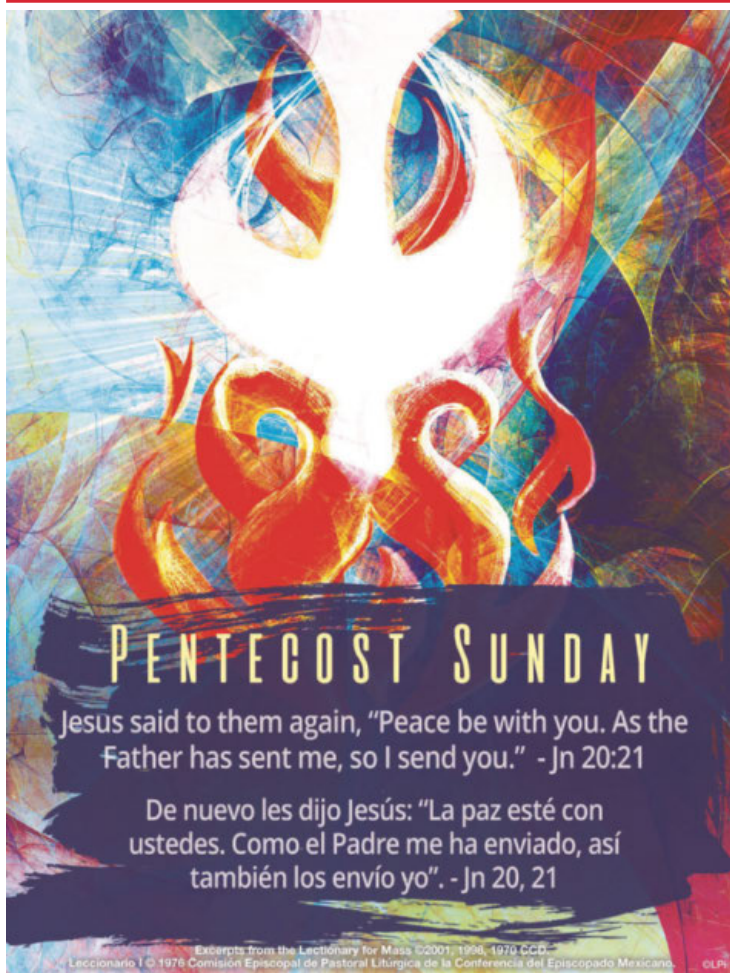

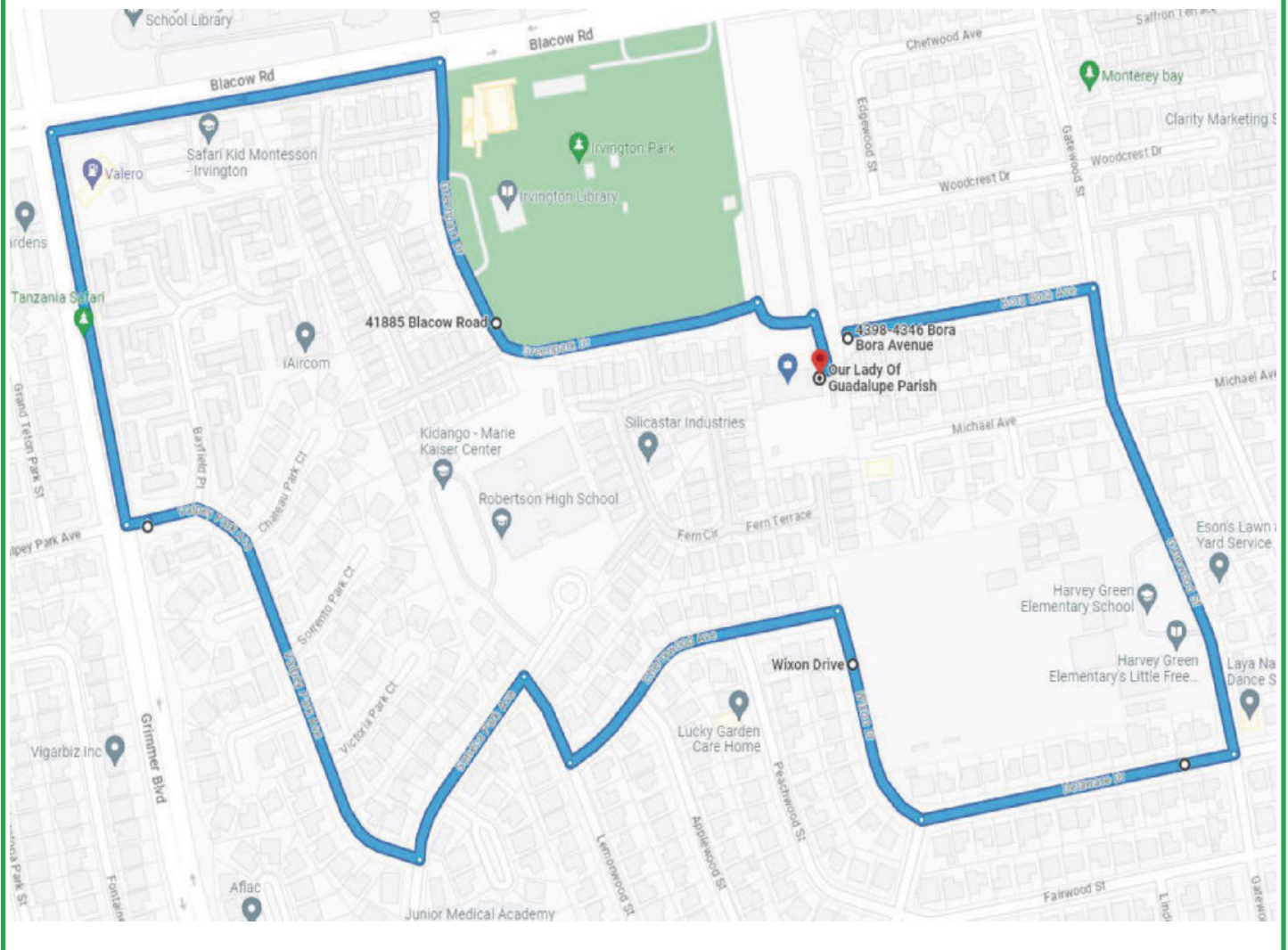

MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

The miracle of Our Lady of Guadalupe is perhaps one of the clearest and most dramatic historical examples of how Christ brings his people together through his Body the Church. The popular image of Our Lady has hung in the Basilica of Blessed Mother in Mexico City for over 475 years, and scientists who have examined it agree it is not of natural or human origin.

Before Columbus arrived in America, Mexico was a naturally beautiful yet morally dark world. Ruled mostly by the Aztecs, the culture rested on a pagan religion that demanded continual, bloody, and violent human sacrifices.

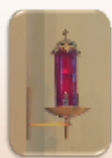
The Spanish, led by Hernan Cortes, conquered Mexico in 1521. They put an end to the pagan worship practices and gratuitous slaughter. Though many dedicated missionaries came to Mexico, they had difficulty bringing the native peoples to the Christian faith. This was because some prominent European colonialists there gave bad personal example and heartlessly exploited the conquered population.

The Bishop of Mexico City at the time even wrote to the Holy Roman Emperor, Charles V, saying that **unless God directly intervened, there would be no way to convert the Mexicans.** Historians have even said that in 1531 a revolt among former Aztecs was a real possibility, which would have set off a chain of violence ending in mass genocide for both races.

Just then the Virgin Mary appeared to a little Indian named Juan Diego, and her message and image touched both the Europeans and the natives so tenderly that a mass conversion followed. Today both races have blended to form one Mexican nation, and the shrine housing the miraculous image attracts 18-20 million pilgrims every year, making it the most visited Catholic shrine in the world. In this beautiful **"Pentecost Experience"**, the power of the Holy Spirit was made manifest through the mediation of our Blessed Mother - Mary.

MENSAJE DEL PÁRROCO

El milagro de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe es quizás uno de los más claros y más dramáticos ejemplos históricos de cómo Cristo une a su pueblo a través de su Cuerpo, la Iglesia. La popular imagen de Nuestra Señora ha estado colgada en la Basílica de la Santísima Madre en la Ciudad de México durante más de 475 años, y los científicos que la han examinado están de acuerdo en que no es de origen natural ni humano.

Antes de que Colón llegara a América, México era naturalmente hermoso pero moralmente un mundo oscuro. Gobernada principalmente por los aztecas, la cultura se basaba en una religión pagana que exigía sacrificios humanos continuos, sangrientos y violentos.

Los españoles, encabezados por Hernán Cortés, conquistaron México en 1521. Pusieron fin a las prácticas de culto pagano y la matanza gratuita. Aunque muchos misioneros dedicados vinieron a México, tuvieron dificultades para llevar a los pueblos nativos a la fe cristiana. Esto se debió a que algunos destacados colonialistas europeos allí dieron mal ejemplo personal y explotaron sin piedad a la población conquistada.

El obispo de la Ciudad de México en ese momento incluso le escribió al Emperador del Sacro Imperio Romano Germánico, Carlos V, diciendo que **a menos que Dios interviniera directamente, no habría forma de convertir a los Mexicanos**. Los historiadores incluso han dicho que en 1531 una revuelta entre los antiguos aztecas era una posibilidad real, lo que habría desencadenado una cadena de violencia que terminaría en un genocidio masivo para ambas razas.

En ese momento la Virgen María se apareció a un pequeño indio llamado Juan Diego, y su mensaje e imagen conmovió tanto a los europeos como a los nativos con tanta ternura que siguió una conversión masiva. Hoy, ambas razas se han fusionado para formar una nación Mexicana, y el santuario que alberga la imagen milagrosa atrae entre 18 y 20 millones de peregrinos cada año, lo que lo convierte en el santuario católico más visitado del mundo. En esta hermosa **"Experiencia de Pentecostés"**, el poder del Espíritu Santo se manifestó a través de la mediación de nuestra Santísima Madre - María.

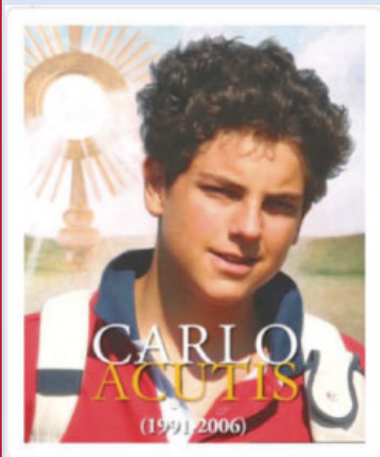

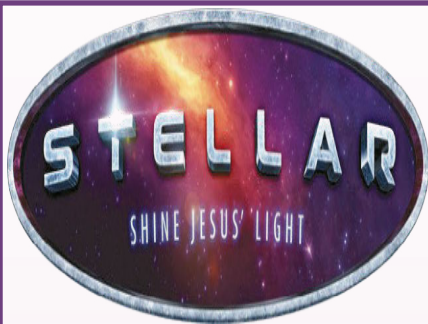

Want to WIN as Mom and Dad? “Focus on What’s Important Now”.

As a mom and dad, do you have a hard time recognizing your success. We get burned out when we are focusing on the Tasks on our list. We define ourselves by our level of productivity. Focus on What’s Important Now. When feeling overwhelmed ask yourself, What’s important now?

- Yes, dishes are important, but what is important now, is that your child is asking you to play with him or her or have conversation about something.
- Yes, laundry is there, but what is important now is, everyone is sleeping, and you have bit of time to take care of yourself or may be right now everyone in the family needs to work together as a team, put on some music and get the dishes done, clean the house together as a family.
- When you stop back and ask yourself, “What’s Important Now, you will find more peace and joy.
- Success is when you take a few minutes to engage with each child with a hug, comments that uplift them, help a child to overcome something difficult, pray with them, laughing together.

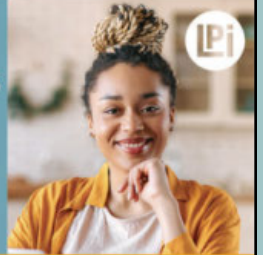
