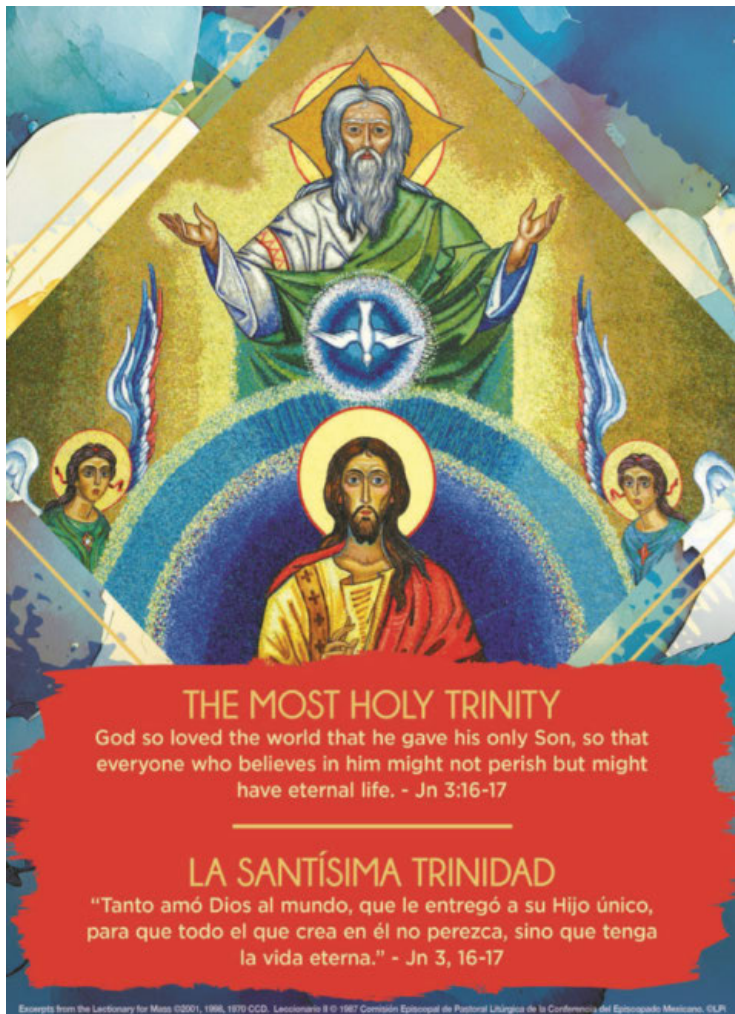

As we profess our faith in this Triune God who has loved us so deeply, let's thank him from the bottom of our hearts, and promise that we will never let sin, selfishness, or doubts separate us from this unimaginably dignified calling.

FAMILY ENRICHMENT

“Family First” / “La Familia Primero”

“Good Discipline versus Setting kids up to fail”.

Any time you expect your kids to listen, obey, or complete the task without having good evidence that they can do that thing successfully, we are leading them into temptation, we are setting them up to fail. For example, cleaning the Garage, Car, House, etc., It does not matter whether you think they should be able to do it. It only matters that we have seen that they have the skill to do that thing successfully. If they have demonstrated consistent mastery of task of skill, we have right to expect that behavior from them. If not, then they have a right to expect that the parents will give them help and support.

How to help?

- Show our children how to do something three or four times before you ask them to do it.
- First time they do, offer gentle support and suggestions.
- Set aside your agenda/priorities and focus on showing children what to do instead of instructing them.
- Don't be frustrated when they are not able to do it.
- For urgent, stressful, all-day tasks don't leave them alone to do.

Cada vez que espera que sus hijos escuchen, obedezcan o completen la tarea sin tener una buena evidencia de que pueden hacerlo con éxito, los estamos conduciendo a la tentación, los estamos preparando para que fracasen. Por ejemplo, limpiar el garaje, el coche, la casa, etc., no importa si crees que deberían poder hacerlo. Solo importa que hayamos visto que tienen la habilidad para hacer eso con éxito. Si han demostrado un dominio constante de la tarea de habilidad, tenemos derecho a esperar ese comportamiento de ellos. De lo contrario, tienen derecho a esperar que los padres les brinden ayuda y apoyo.

¿Como ayudar?

- Muestre a nuestros hijos cómo hacer algo tres o cuatro veces antes de pedirles que lo hagan ellos solos.
- La primera vez que lo hagan, ofrezca apoyo amable y sugerencias.
- Deje a un lado su agenda/prioridades y concéntrese en mostrarles a los niños qué hacer en lugar de instruirlos.
- No te frustres cuando no puedan hacerlo.
- Para tareas urgentes, estresantes y de todo el día, no los deje solos.
