“Upon this rock I will build my Church”! That was Christ’s promise to St. Peter at Caesarea Philippi. Now the Church built on the rock of St. Peter, entrusts to us Catholics a special mission which ultimately comes from Christ. And that mission is **“to be his missionary in our times”!** To accomplish that mission, we are all like soldiers of Christ’s Kingdom, carrying his saving light into the world’s many dark prisons of sin.

All soldiers need weapons. The Christian’s weapons are not swords, guns, or bombs. We do not fight for an earthly kingdom. Our fight is against sin, the spiritual tyranny of selfishness that leads to suffering, injustice, and unhappiness. **And so, our weapons must be spiritual.** And the better we know how to use our weapons, the more fulfilling our Christian adventure will be. Three key Christian weapons are available to each of us all the time.

First, PRAYER. Prayer is our communications system and supply line linking us to headquarters. If we learn to pray regularly and well, we will never lack inspiration, strength, and comfort in our Christian adventure.

Second, THE BIBLE. The Bible is God’s inspired Word, a treasure chest of supernatural wisdom. If we read it and study it, always under the guidance of the Holy Spirit, we become spiritually smart.

Third, THE GREAT COMMANDMENT to LOVE. Before his crucifixion and death, Jesus gave his followers a new commandment: **“Love one another as I have loved you”** (John 15:12).

These are the keys that unlock the spiritual chains worn by so many of our brothers and sisters. As Christ renews his commitment to us, let’s renew our commitment to him, confident that no matter what happens in this life, we will be victorious in the end, because, as he promised, the gates of the netherworld will not prevail against the rock and the keys.

Ahora bien, la Iglesia edificada sobre la roca de San Pedro, nos confía a los católicos una misión especial que en última instancia viene de Cristo. **¡Y esa misión es “ser su misionero en nuestros tiempos”!** Para cumplir esa misión, todos somos como soldados del Reino de Cristo, llevando su luz salvadora a las muchas prisiones oscuras del pecado del mundo.

Todos los soldados necesitan armas. Las armas del Cristiano no son espadas, pistolas o bombas. No luchamos por un reino terrenal. Nuestra lucha es contra el pecado, la tiranía espiritual del egoísmo que conduce al sufrimiento, la injusticia y la infelicidad. **Y así, nuestras armas deben ser espirituales.** Y cuanto mejor sepamos cómo usar nuestras armas, más satisfactoria será nuestra aventura cristiana. Tres armas cristianas claves están disponibles para cada uno de nosotros todo el tiempo.

Primero, ORACIÓN. La oración es nuestro sistema de comunicación y la línea de suministro que nos une a la sede. Si aprendemos a rezar bien y con regularidad, nunca nos faltará inspiración, fuerza y consuelo en nuestra aventura Cristiana.

Segundo, LA BIBLIA. La Biblia es la Palabra inspirada de Dios, un cofre del tesoro de sabiduría sobrenatural. Si lo leemos y lo estudiamos, siempre bajo la guía del Espíritu Santo, nos volvemos espiritualmente inteligentes.

Tercero, EL GRAN MANDAMIENTO de AMAR. Antes de su crucifixión y muerte, Jesús dio a sus seguidores un nuevo mandamiento: **"Amense los unos a los otros como yo los he amado"** (Juan 15:12).

Estas son las llaves que abren las cadenas espirituales que llevan tantos de nuestros hermanos y hermanas. “Family First” / “La Familia Primero”

Where does our children’s misbehaving come from?

Parents think that the teens misbehave because they need to test their limits, to see how much they can get away with. This way of looking at our children can make you look at them as someone opposed to you. Sociologist Murray Strauss found out that misbehavior, disrespect, resistance is rooted in the negative intent of a young person. This can give an idea that they are born bad and stay bad even after years of life. Fr. Edward Flanagan (founder of Boys and Girls Town) says “There are no bad [children]” as such. There is only a bad environment, bad training, bad example, and bad thinking. No teenager is born bad or born to be bad.

- ♦ By **building healthy attachment** with our kids, we can help our kids to connect into their natural, God-given desire to be a good person.
- ♦ Child development experts have a saying, “When children feel well, they behave well. **Try to know what they feel.**”
- ♦ Bad behavior is a sign that the teen is **going through a pain and needs help**, it is our work as parents to find out their pain and help them.

¿De dónde viene el mal comportamiento de nuestros hijos?

Los padres piensan que los adolescentes se portan mal porque necesitan probar sus límites, para ver cuánto pueden salirse con la suya. Esta forma de mirar a nuestros hijos puede hacer que los mires como alguien opuesto a ti. El sociólogo Murray Strauss descubrió que el mal comportamiento, la falta de respeto y la resistencia tienen sus raíces en la intención negativa de una persona joven. Esto puede dar una idea de que nacen malos y se mantienen malos incluso después de años de vida. Padre Edward Flanagan (fundador de Boys and Girls Town) dice “No hay [niños] malos” como tales. Solo hay mal ambiente, mal entrenamiento, mal ejemplo y mal pensamiento. Ningún adolescente nace malo o nace para ser malo.

- ♦ Al **desarrollar un apego saludable** con nuestros hijos, podemos ayudarlos a conectarse con su deseo natural dado por Dios de ser una buena persona.
- ♦ *Los expertos en desarrollo infantil tienen un dicho: “Cuando los niños se sienten bien, se comportan bien. **Trate de saber lo que sienten.**”*
- ♦ El mal comportamiento es señal de que el adolescente **está pasando por un dolor y necesita ayuda**, es nuestra labor como padres conocer su dolor y ayudarlo.

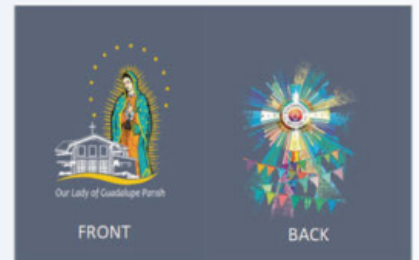

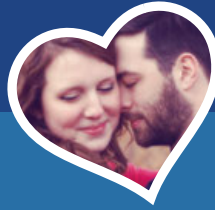
