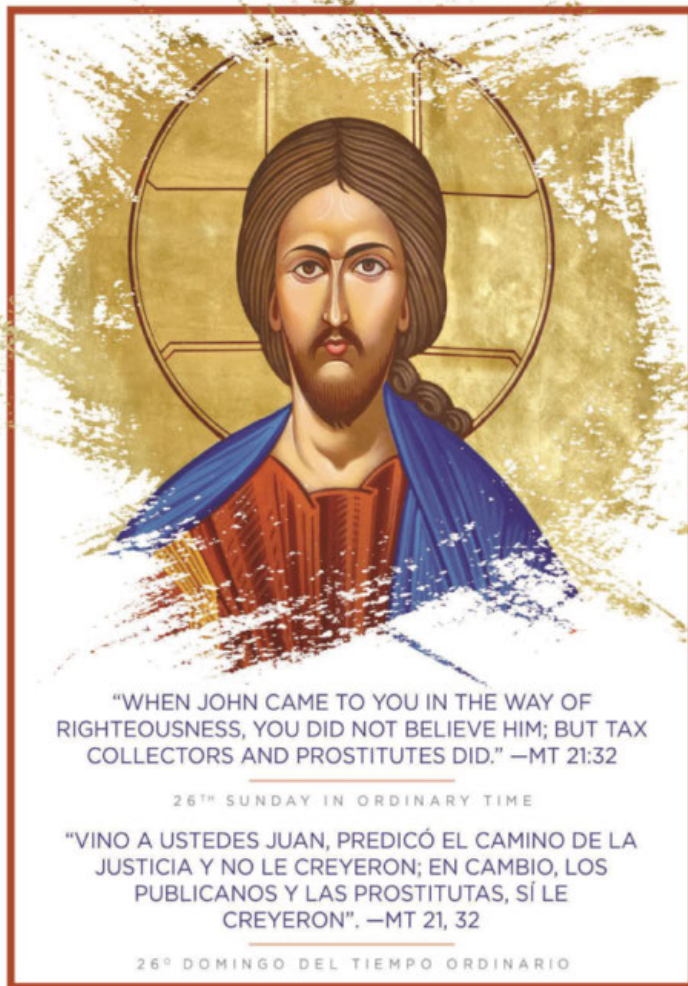

The harmony between words and deeds, appearance, and reality, is so important for Christ that he built it right into the very fiber of Christianity.

All the sacraments, the source of God's grace for the Church, have two elements: **FORM** and **MATTER**. *In Baptism the words of the celebrant are the Form and the Water used is the matter.* In other words: The form is the words that explain the meaning; the matter is the material that is transformed into a channel of grace by those words.

If you have just the matter or just the form, you have no sacrament; you need both.

So, if a priest says the words, "this is my body, this is blood" over a piece of pizza and a glass of orange juice, nothing happens.

But when he pronounces those words of consecration over the unleavened bread and the wine mixed with water during Mass, Christ becomes truly present in the Eucharist.

Likewise, if a penitent goes to confession and receives absolution, but then purposely refuses to fulfill his penance, his/she is not freed from sin. That would be hypocritical - saying he/she is repentant, but not really being repentant.

If we come to Mass on Sunday and say all the right prayers, but then we go to work or school on Monday and make no effort to live as Christ would have us, nothing happens in our souls - our lives don't bear the fruit of the Holy Spirit, because we are not transformed into Christ. **Real faith requires real action.**

The SPRED Diocesan communities in conjunction with the Our Lady of Guadalupe parish community celebrate a special Liturgy for SPRED catechists, Friends, and their families. We are blessed to have this program in our parish.

La armonía entre palabras y hechos, apariencia y realidad, es tan importante para Cristo que la incorporó a la fibra misma del cristianismo.

Todos los sacramentos, fuente de la gracia de Dios para la Iglesia, tienen dos elementos: **FORMA** y **MATERIA**. En el Bautismo las palabras del celebrante son la Forma y el Agua utilizada es la materia. En otras palabras: La forma son las palabras que explican el significado; la materia es la materia que se transforma en canal de gracia por esas palabras.

Si tienes sólo la materia o sólo la forma, no tienes sacramento; necesitas ambos.

Entonces, si un sacerdote dice las palabras "esto es mi cuerpo, esto es mi sangre" sobre un trozo de pizza y un vaso de jugo de naranja, no pasa nada.

Pero cuando pronuncia esas palabras de consagración sobre los panes sin levadura y el vino mezclado con agua durante la Misa, Cristo se hace verdaderamente presente en la Eucaristía.

Asimismo, si un penitente se confiesa y recibe la absolución, pero luego intencionadamente se niega a cumplir su penitencia, no queda libre del pecado. Sería hipócrita... decir que está arrepentido, pero no estar realmente arrepentido.

Si vamos a Misa el domingo y decimos todas las oraciones correctas, pero luego vamos al trabajo o a la escuela el lunes y no hacemos ningún esfuerzo por vivir como Cristo quiere que vivamos, no sucede nada en nuestras almas: nuestras vidas no dan los frutos del Espíritu Santo, porque no nos hemos transformado en Cristo. **La verdadera fe requiere acción real.**

Las comunidades Diocesanas de SPRED en conjunto con la comunidad parroquial de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe celebran una Liturgia especial para los catequistas, Amigos y sus familias de SPRED. Tenemos la suerte de tener este programa en nuestra parroquia.

“Family First” / “La Familia Primero”

Is your relationship deep with your kids?

Your children need to know that you love them. Not “in your own way” but in a close and personal way that their own experience of you can’t deny. When your children think of you, the first word that ought to come to their mind is “support”. We all want to be strong parents, especially the Dads. We want our children to look up to us. To admire us and to see us as examples. To turn to us for life’s important lessons. This is a good and godly desire. God created this desire in us, and moreover created a way that this desire would be fulfilled. It can be done through something called, “attachment”. God has created structures in your children’s brains that make them open up when they feel understood by someone.

Feeling understood and empathized with, stimulates your kid’s brain’s attachment, which facilitates a sense of bonding and connection. It is simple as this; we listen to whomever we feel attached to. The more our kids feel like we share their feelings and “get to know” their struggle, cry with them, the more likely they will listen to us and allow us to disciple them.

¿Es profunda su relación con sus hijos?

Tus hijos necesitan saber que los amas. No “a tu manera”, sino de una manera cercana y personal que su propia experiencia de ti no puede negar. Cuando tus hijos piensan en ti, la primera palabra que les debe venir a la mente es “apoyo”. Todos queremos ser padres fuertes, especialmente los papás. Queremos que nuestros hijos nos admiren. Admirarnos y vernos como ejemplos. Para acudir a nosotros en busca de lecciones importantes de la vida. Este es un deseo bueno y piadoso. Dios creó este deseo en nosotros y, además, creó una manera en que este deseo se cumpliría. Se puede hacer a través de algo llamado “apego”. Dios ha creado estructuras en el cerebro de tus hijos que los hacen abrirse cuando se sienten comprendidos por alguien.

Sentirse comprendido y empatizado estimula el apego cerebral de su hijo, lo que facilita una sensación de vínculo y conexión. Es así de simple; escuchamos a quien nos sentimos apegados. Cuanto más sientan nuestros hijos que compartimos sus sentimientos y “conocemos” su lucha, lloramos con ellos, es más probable que nos escuchen y nos permitan discipularlos.

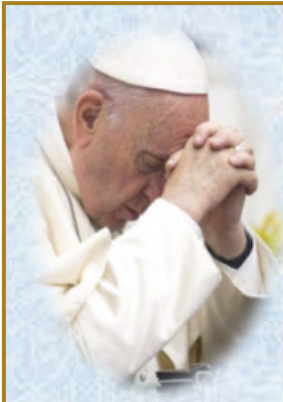

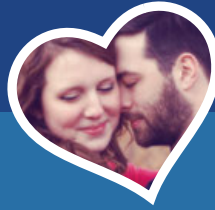

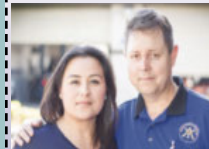
