Pastors Message,

There is part of the Creed, saying that we "**believe in one, holy, catholic, and apostolic Church.**" The Church is one because all its members believe the same faith, celebrate with the same sacraments, and follow the same authority under the guidance of the Holy Father.

Today we celebrate "Good Shepherd Sunday". It reminds us of Church's job to reunite the human race into one spiritual family. Pope Pius IX once had a chance encounter that wonderfully expresses this unity and universality of Christ's one flock. One day he was walking alone through the Vatican galleries. He came upon a young Englishman who was gazing rapturously at one of Raphael's paintings.

The Holy Father watched him from a distance, and then went up to him, saying, "I assume you are an artist, my son?" The young man admitted that he had come to Rome to study painting but didn't have enough money to pay for instruction at the Academy. Pope Pius generously offered to give him a scholarship. "But, your Holiness," exclaimed the British youth, "I'm not even Catholic!" "Don't worry," the Holy Father answered with a smile, "Admission to the studios will not be denied you on that account." Christ's flock is one, but it is also universal, called to draw all people into the arms of the good shepherd.

Today, Sunday April 22nd we also celebrate "**Earth Day**" which was founded in 1970 as a day of education about environmental issues. Now it is a global celebration that's sometimes extended into Earth Week, a full seven days of events focused on green living. Education and action are the two most valuable steps we can take to protect our planet, keep our home, church and community clean and spotless. It's a time for us to ask ourselves on how much we do engage for this cause.

Earth day is a day of action and participation. It is not just to march, sign petitions, meet with elected officials, plant trees, it is a time to clean up our homes, churches, community and commit ourselves to that cause. Pope Francis, reminds us that we need to connect Earth Day with protecting God's greatest creations, humans, all living creatures and the planet that we all live on.

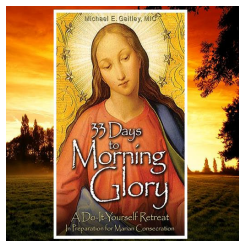

Mensaje del Pastor,

Hay una parte en el Credo que dice, "**creo en una sola Iglesia, santa, católica y apostólica.**" La iglesia es solo una porque todos sus miembros tienen la misma fe, celebran los mismos sacramentos y siguen a la misma autoridad bajo la dirección del Santo Padre.

El día de hoy celebramos "El Domingo del Buen Pastor". Nos recuerda el trabajo de la iglesia que es reunir a la raza humana en una sola familia espiritual. El Papa Pío IX tuvo un encuentro que expresa maravillosamente esta unidad y universalidad del único rebaño de Cristo. Un día iba caminando él solo por las Galerías del Vaticano y encontró a un joven inglés que estaba mirando con mucho entusiasmo una de las pinturas de Rafael. El Santo Padre lo miró a distancia, y luego se acercó a él diciendo, "Hijo, ¿asumo que tú eres un artista?" El joven aceptó y le dijo que había ido a Roma a estudiar pintura, pero no tenía el dinero suficiente para pagar por su instrucción en la Academia.

El Papa Pío, generosamente le ofreció darle una beca. El joven inglés le respondió, "Pero, su Santidad," "¡Ni siquiera soy católico!" "No te preocupes, le contesto el Santo Padre, con una sonrisa, "No se te va a negar el ingreso a los estudios por ese motivo." El rebaño de Cristo es uno, pero también es universal, es llamado a atraer a todas las personas a los brazos del buen pastor.

Hoy, domingo 22 de abril, también celebramos el "**Día de la Tierra**" que fue fundado en 1970 como un día de educación sobre temas medioambientales. Ahora, es un día que se celebra en todo el mundo y algunas veces se extiende a Semana de la Tierra, siete días completos de eventos enfocados en la protección del ambiente. Educación y acción son los dos pasos más valiosos que podemos tomar para proteger nuestro planeta, mantener nuestra casa, nuestra Iglesia y nuestra comunidad limpia y sin mancha. Es un momento para preguntarnos cómo y cuánto nos vamos a comprometer nosotros mismos en esa causa.

El Día de la Tierra es un día de acción y participación. No solo es para marchar, firmar peticiones, reunirnos con funcionarios electos y plantar árboles, es un tiempo para limpiar nuestras casas, comunidad y comprometernos a esa causa.
