## *Pastor's Message*

We had a beautiful celebration of the centennial feast of the apparitions of Blessed Virgin Mary in Fatima. At the General Audience presided at St. Peter's Square on Oct. 11, 2017, the Pope Francis spoke of this anniversary.

Pope Francis invited all faithful to pray the rosary for peace. *"Looking back to the Mother of the Lord and Queen of Missions, I invite everyone, especially in this month of October, to pray the holy rosary for peace in the world."* He also reminded the faithful *"I encourage you to continue joyfully your journey of faith, under the solicitous and tender gaze of our celestial Mother."*

As I gaze toward our Blessed Mother, what strikes me most is her healthy sense of gratitude. *"My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord"*. We learn from our heavenly Mother that beautiful quality of gratitude and we realize that, **ingratitude is the substance of every sin**, and sin separates us from God, and from the meaningful life that comes from living close to God - it keeps us from accepting God's invitations.

Also, this week's gospel parable shows us exactly how to grow this rare and powerful virtue of gratitude: by letting God change our plans. If the invited guests in the parable had truly respected their king, they would have adjusted their plans for his sake, putting aside their personal preferences for a little while to show their gratitude to him.

The evil of sin, of self-centeredness, stems ultimately from its ingratitude. Our first duty in relation to God consists in humbly accepting his generous gifts, in letting him be for us the kind of King he really is. And so, a healthy sense of gratitude is one of the best ways to combat sin and stay close to the Lord and Mary our heavenly Mother becomes for us the best model. **In this month of October, dedicated to Our Heavenly Mother, Let us ask her to help us grow in Gratitude.**
